He wanted to blend in with the other people at the party.



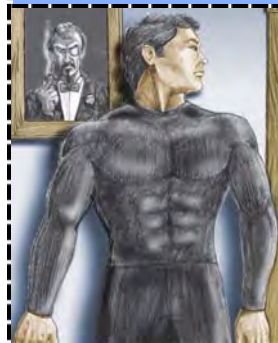
When Conrad locates Carmen at the party, they will probably
