

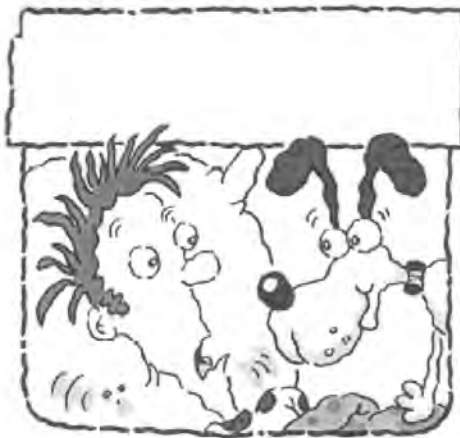
# Dr. Little Comic Book

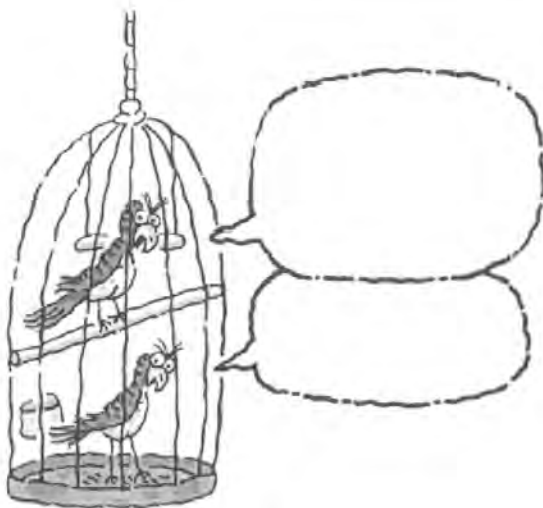
## Matching Game
